

How to measure your ring size accurately

Step 1



Cut a slip of paper and wrap around your finger

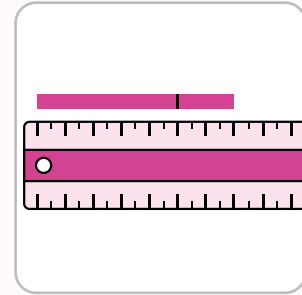
(Don't use string - it stretches)

Step 2



Mark the point where the end of the paper meets.


Step 3



Use a ruler to measure the inside circumference. Refer to the table above.

To ensure this document prints at the correct size, please ensure your printer is not set to 'Fit to page or printable area'. To obtain your ring size, simply place an existing ring over the circles until the circles fit snugly against the inside edge of your ring.
